This Week: WHAT IS THE EIGHTH COMMANDMENT?

Answer: "You shall not steal."

Next Week: WHAT DOES THE EIGHTH COMMANDMENT MEAN?

Answer: The Eighth Commandment teaches that private ownership must be respected and not violated in any way.
