## CROSS TIMBERS CATECHISM

### This Week: WHAT IS JUSTIFICATION?

Answer: Justification is the act whereby God declares the sinner forgiven of his sins and in right standing with him (Romans 5:1). When we place our faith in Christ, his righteous life and his death become ours. He paid to God what we owed and could not pay (Romans 3:21–25; 2 Corinthians 5:21).

### Next Week: WHAT IS SANCTIFICATION?

Answer: Sanctification is the process a Christian enters at conversion in which he becomes more and more holy throughout his life (1 Thessalonians 5:23).
