## CROSS TIMBERS CATECHISM

**This Week: WHAT HAPPENED AFTER JESUS DIED AND WAS BURIED?**

Answer: On the third day Jesus rose from the grave, never to die again (Luke 24:1-8). This rising is called the resurrection.

**Next Week: WHERE IS JESUS NOW?**

Answer: Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven (Acts 1:1-3) where he now lives, seated at the right hand of the Father (Colossians 3:1).
