CROSS TIMBERS CATECHISM

This Week: WHAT IS THE CHURCH?

Answer: The church is a local organization of believers, joined together to worship God (Acts 13:2), to teach and learn the Scriptures (Romans 16:25), to hold one another accountable (Matthew 18:15-17), and to serve as a witness to unbelievers (1 Thessalonians 1:8).

Next Week: WHAT ARE THE BASIC OFFICERS OF THE CHURCH?

Answer: The pastor is the main preacher and teacher of the church, who exercises oversight over the group (1 Timothy 3:1-7). Deacons are godly men who assist the pastor and congregation in carrying out the mission of the church (1 Timothy 3:8-10).
